PRE-VISIT

BOOKING AND SECURING YOUR SCHOOL TRIP

Simply contact our events team to check availability and to book your adventure. To do this you can either request a quote online at www.goape.co.uk/ groups/schools or call the team direct on 01284 852229.

When you book with us, you will receive a personal events coordinator who will help you plan the perfect adventure for you and your tribe.

To secure your place, we require a 25% deposit and full payment 10 working days before your event.

If your event is within 10 working days of booking, then full payment will be required.

MAKING CHANGES TO YOUR EVENT

We are happy to accommodate up to three changes to your event up to 10 working days before your event once your booking has been secured.

Please note changes to numbers may affect the activity you are able to participate in.

OUR CANCELLATION POLICY

In the event you wish to cancel the booking, you must confirm in writing to the Go Ape education team via schools@goape.co.uk

Unfortunately, verbal cancellations will not be accepted.

The following cancellation charges apply:

28 days +	25% (the deposit)
14-28 days	50%
1–14 days	100%

WHEN DO SCHOOL RATES APPLY?

School rates apply Monday – Friday term time only.

DO YOU HAVE HOME SCHOOLING RATES?

Yes, our Home Schooling rates are the same as the Schools rate and apply Monday – Friday within term time.

Please note we are unable to print your learning resources on the day therefore please do this prior to your arrival.

ARRIVING ON TIME AND FINDING US

We're a pretty relaxed bunch at Go Ape, but it's really important you arrive on time for the start of your session or you could miss your slot in the trees. We recommend arriving at least 15 minutes prior to your allotted start time.

Please check your route before you head out so there's no chance of being late and missing your slot. Do note if you are late, we can't guarantee we will have space for you to take part in your activity that day.

If you are running late for your session, please try to call us as soon as possible on 01284 852229. Alternatively, you can contact your event's organiser directly.

Arriving early gives you and your tribe enough time to book in at the Cabin and learn the ropes before your adventure begins without any stress or disappointment.

Please note that woodlands don't stick to postcode boundaries so please don't rely on your SatNav to get you to us. 'Old-fashioned' maps and our directions (available via our website https://goape. co.uk/days-out) will bring you right to our door, if followed correctly.

Upon arrival, please head to the cabin where you

will be greeted by a member of the team who will book you in accordingly.

PARKING

Parking charges are implemented by the forest owners and not by Go Ape, therefore parking charges may apply. Charges will vary depending on which location you visit, so please make sure you have plenty of change.

You can arrange your parking in advance with your events coordinator. If pre-paid parking is detailed in your quote, then your parking vouchers will be sent separately. Each site is different. Your events coordinator will help advise.

Parking is available at all locations, except Battersea Park.

Some sites may have restricted access for coaches due to their location, please speak to your coordinator for more information.

Some sites, such as Alexandra Palace, Battersea Palace and Cockfosters can be accessed by public transport. Please speak to your coordinator for more information.

BEHAVIOUR

Whilst we encourage fun, please note that if students are misbehaving then our site staff have the right to remove participants from the activity.

WHAT TO WEAR

Go Ape is an outdoor activity, so we suggest you wear something you don't mind getting grubby, and of course, dress for the weather!

No open-toed or slip-on footwear is permitted on the courses. Please wear secure closed-toe footwear with a good grip. We recommend anklesupporting shoes such as trainers.

Some people like to wear gloves, especially if it's cold. You can buy these in advance with your event coordinator or if you forget they are available on the day in the cabin for £3.50.



Long hair has to be tied back, waists covered, and body piercings removed or taped over as the participants will be wearing harnesses.

Please note there are no changing facilities at any of our Go Ape Forest adventures.

If you are attending Nets Adventure, please be aware if it is raining you may need a spare set of clothing.

VALUABLES

We do not recommend that you bring valuables with you, such as laptops, as leaving these in your vehicles will be at your own risk. We are however able to store small personal items, such as watches, phones, wallets and keys in our onsite cabin. The cabin is attended at all times by a Go Ape member of staff.

Please note that valuables are still left at your own risk and there are limited spaces in the cabin.

FAQS

CAN I BRING A CAMERA/PHONE?

Phones and cameras are permitted at most sites, as long as they always stay attached to the participant. Lanyards are available to buy from the cabin, subject to availability. Battersea Park operates a no camera policy on the course.

WHAT HAPPENS IN BAD WEATHER?

Go Ape is an excellent wet weather activity – and rain only adds to the fun!

The course remains open in all weathers, except when it is icy, very windy, stormy or during lightning.

Sometimes, unfortunately, we might need to close the course for reasons beyond our control, if this happens you will be contacted.

WHERE ARE THE TOILETS?

The toilets are located just a few minutes' walk from the course at all our locations.

CAN WE BRING OUR OWN LUNCH?

Absolutely - there are picnic benches around the forest at most locations.

Alternatively, if you have a large group you can book our forest shelter to dine under or depending on location, a conference room. Please note conference rooms are not available at all locations. Additional charges will apply for both forest shelter and conference rooms.

Please speak to your events coordinator directly for more information, as they can arrange this for you.

ARE THERE WATER STATIONS ON SITE?

We have water stations available at certain points on the Treetop Challenge course and in the Nets Adventure area.

Please speak to a member of staff at your location for more information on water stations as locations vary depending on site.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO COMPLETE?

Please note length of activity depends on group size, your events co-ordinator can help identify course length with your group.

DO I NEED TO BRING ANYTHING WITH ME?

We'll provide all the equipment necessary for you to take part. All you need to do is ensure you're wearing suitable clothing and footwear to take part. Please see 'what to wear' for more information.

We also recommend a pair of gloves for comfort whilst holding onto the ropes. You can buy these in advance with your event coordinator or if you forget they are available on the day in the cabin for £3.50.

DO YOU PROVIDE GIFT BAGS?

Yes, please speak to your events coordinator to buy your gift bags in advance. Gift bags are £5 each and can include a yo-yo, pencil, colouring pencils, monkey mask and a medal.

Alternatively, you can speak to your events coordinator and buy additional individual items in advance. Such as keyrings for £1 or gloves for £3.50.

DO YOU HAVE A GIFT SHOP?

Whilst we don't have a 'gift shop' you can purchase a selection Go Ape merchandise from the cabin after your adventure. Your tribe can choose from t-shirts, jumpers, gloves, lanyards and keyrings.

Prices range from £1 for a keyring to £35 for an adult jumper.

Simply visit the cabin on site for more information or you can buy these in advance with your events coordinator.
